CAPTION: 1980.

PENNY:
[off camera] No more than one or two babe? I've got dinner on the go.

OLLY:
Okay. [shuts front door and begins his walk to the pub]

CUT TO:

Various angles of his journey, wooded areas etc. He walks along. He lights up a fag. As he goes along, we see him in long shot and sense there is someone waiting for him. There is. We see firstly the man's scar on his face and tattoo close to his ear and then his face is revealed in full. It is OLLY's twin brother KEITH who tries to block OLLY's way. He is in the Navy and wears Navy uniform and has a little bag with him. They don't get on. There is tension between them. KEITH is very crazed and drunk. He has a whiskey bottle with him.

KEITH:
Hello Ollly!

OLLY:
[startled] Keith?

KEITH:
Yes.

OLLY:
[still in shock] I... It's been a long time.

KEITH:
Oh yes a very long time.

OLLY:
What are you doing here?

KEITH:
[in a threatening tone] Well I'm back on leave. Thought I'd look up my twin brother and his family, if that's okay.

OLLY:
Well we're fine thank you. We don't want any more trouble, Keith.

KEITH:
I'm not here to cause any trouble. I'm just here to take what is mine. How's my Penny?
